All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

To pay for an entry scanned and attached to email to PARRKEES@mac.com use PayPal services, payable to account for PARRKEES@mac.com. Add \$4.00 for each entry form to the correct entry fee amount. You must email the front and back of entry form for it to be accepted, completely filled out and signed. Notification must be received by the show secretary from PayPal that the funds have been deposited before the entry will be accepted.

Entries not on an official AKC entry form are not acceptable and photocopies of the entry form must have the Agreement and Instructions included.

The Basset Hound Club of Southern California, Inc. and Basset Hound Club of America, Inc. may deny entries to these shows due to outstanding monetary obligations to the club.

Effective for all events held after January 1, 2008, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. The current \$5.00 recording fee will continue to be collected. (Chapter 11, Section 2, Rules Applying to Dog Shows, published by the American Kennel Club. There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.) In Rally, AKC will collect a \$3.50 Recording Fee for each entry of a dog.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, whoever may make such errors. Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, bitch in season, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If, because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund or entry fee(s) will be made.

Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championship is unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed competition, provided the transfer is made with the show secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

Acknowledgment of entry will be made with an exhibitor's ticket and judging program. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the show secretary at (760) 946-9048. Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their area.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure that their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

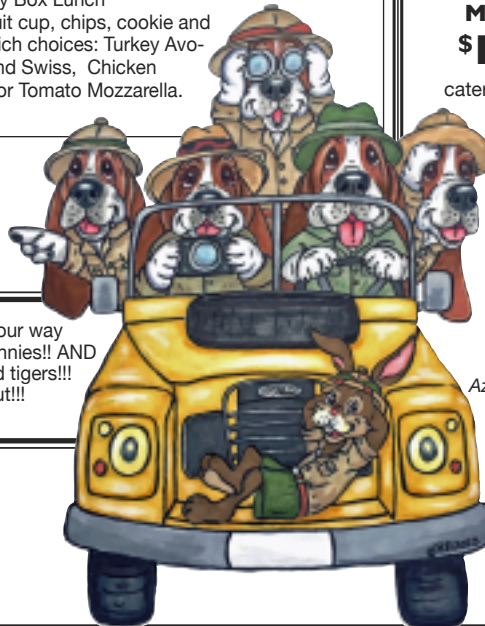

CHALLENGE TROPHIES

ALL CHALLENGE TROPHIES — Trophy must be returned to the trophy chairman in satisfactory condition and properly engraved prior to the official start of the next specialty show. Excessive damage (damage beyond normal wear and tear) should be repaired prior to the return of the trophy. Engraving charges will be reimbursed upon presentation of bill to club treasurer. No trophies will be mailed.

The following trophies are offered by various donors through the Basset Hound Club of Southern California for competition at its specialty shows only. For permanent possession, these trophies must be won three times by the same owner(s) not necessarily with the same dog or bitch.

Best of Breed The Basset Hound Club of Southern California offers a Waterford Bowl on a walnut base.

Best of Opp. Sex to Best of Breed Woebgon Bassets, Don and Pam Bullock present a large Dannyquest cold-cast bronze Basset Hound bitch on a hand-crafted curly maple base with plaques. The trophy is presented in honor of their three bitches who previously won this award: GCH. Woebgon's Kickapoo Joy Juice, ROM in 2005, CH. Woebgon's Snow White from the BBEX Class in 2007 and GCH. Woebgon's Dodge City Sarsaparilla in 2013.

Winners Dog Ron Lukins and Don & Pam Bullock celebrate 50 years of Desiree Acres breeding champion basset hounds by offering the Winners Dog Challenge Cup in memory of Mary Netzley Lukins. The vintage engraved silver bowl was won by Ch. Oranpark Grover after winning a Hound Group first place in 1970. He was the sire of Desiree Acres foundation studs, Ch. Desiree Acres Pinball Wizard and Ch Desiree Acres Ragtime. The wood base, made from black walnut with zebra wood accents, was donated by Don & Pam Bullock of Woebgon Bassets and was hand-crafted by Don. Special thanks to Maria Bivens for the use of her photograph of Mary Lukins and Baz.

Winners Bitch . . Shoefly Bassets, Andy and Sue Shoemaker offer an Arthur Court tray with rabbit motif on a wood base to the owners of Winners Bitch.

Breeder of Winners Dog Don and Pam Bullock of Woebgon Bassets offer the Ch. Shoefly's Bud Light Memorial Trophy, a bronze bell by C. Wagner cast in the shape of a basset hound head with a clapper shaped like a dog's leg with a massive paw. The bell, number 49 in a limited edition of 1000, was cast in 1978. It is mounted on an oak base with a brass plaque.

Directions to Show

Featherly Regional Park • Canyon RV Park is conveniently situated on the Northwest corner of the 91 Freeway and Gypsum Canyon Road in Anaheim, California.

From the west: Traveling eastbound on the CA-91 Fwy, pass Weir Canyon Road. Take Exit 41 for Gypsum Canyon Road. Turn left at the bottom of the off-ramp. Pass under freeway and turn left at the signal. This will lead you right into the entrance. Specialty location is to the right after entering park.

From the east: Traveling westbound on the CA-91 Fwy toward Beach Cities, pass Green River Road. Take Exit 41A for Gypsum Canyon Road. At the bottom of the off-ramp continue straight through the signal into the park entrance. Specialty location is to the right after entering park.

Day of show parking: Park in the lot across the road. Do not park along the edge of the roadway or on the grass. Small fee is charged.

Field Trial Dogs

Field Trial Bitches

NR1.08500. The Field Trial Dog and Bitch Classes are open to any Basset Hound which has placed in an AKC member or licensed Field Trial. Judging will be on conformation only and the winners of the Field Trial Dog and Field Trial Bitch classes may compete for Best of Breed if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show. A photocopy of the ribbon earned must accompany entry in the Field Trial classes. Entrants in the Field Trial Classes must be intact.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

JUDGE'S AWARDS OF MERIT

At the judge's discretion, an award of merit may be given after awarding BOB, BOS, BOW, Select Dog and Select Bitch to any other basset remaining in the ring. The formula for determining how many Awards of Merit can be given will be: one (1) Award of Merit for every seven (7) entries with five (5) being the maximum

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class – For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the two get, get only to be judged. The owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his two get (not more than 6) and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch Class – For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not be the owner of the produce. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her produce (not more than 6) and must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class – For two (2) dogs or bitches of the same breed with at least one common owner. Both entrants must be intact.

PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS

Dogs that are AKC Champions of Record and dogs that have an AKC Obedience, Rally, Agility, or Tracking degree may be entered for the Parade of Titleholders only. Each dog so entered will be presented with a Rosette with the dog's name printed on it in goldleaf. Each dog's name and the owners' names will be announced at the time of presentation of the Rosette.
